

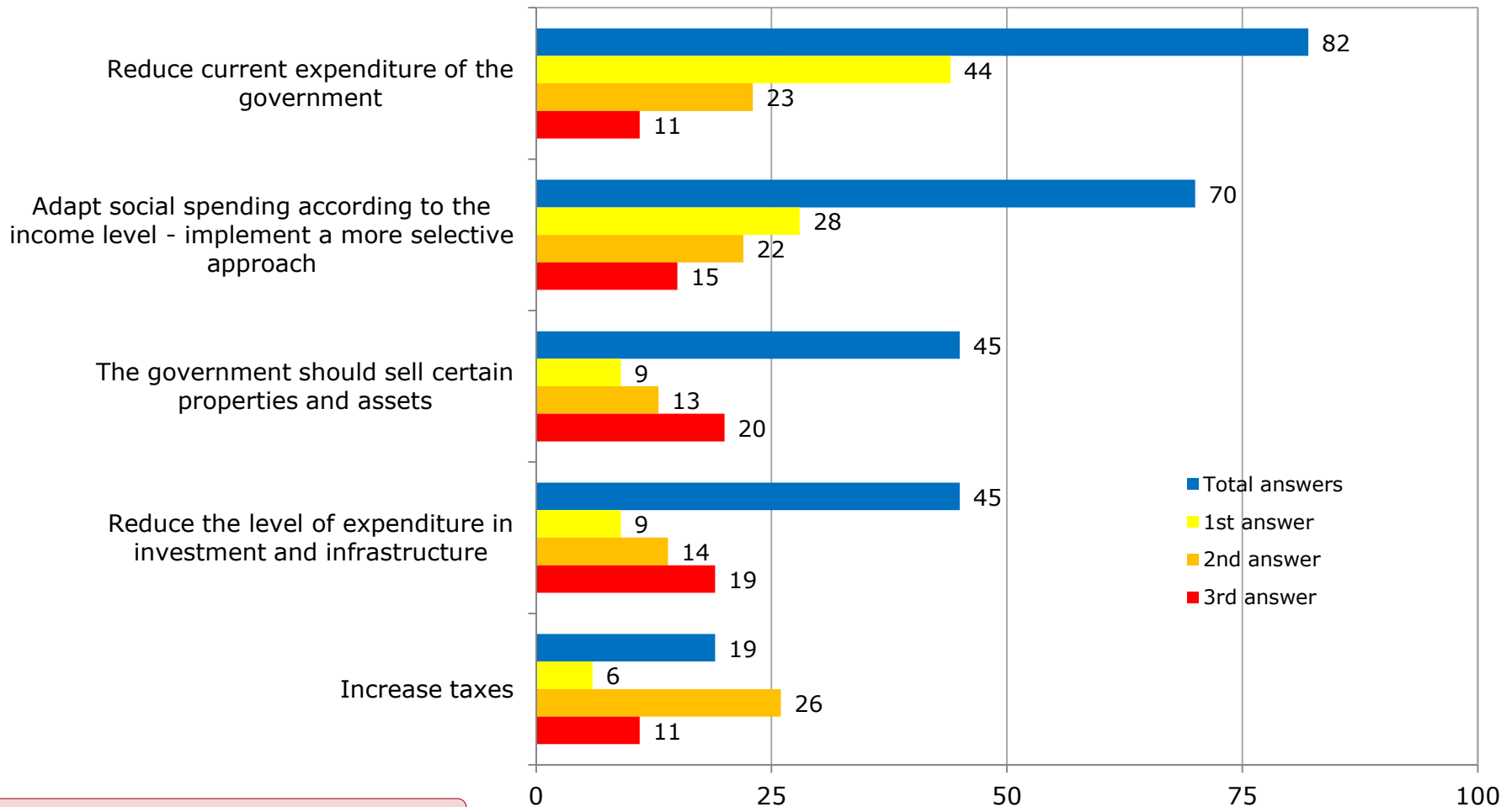

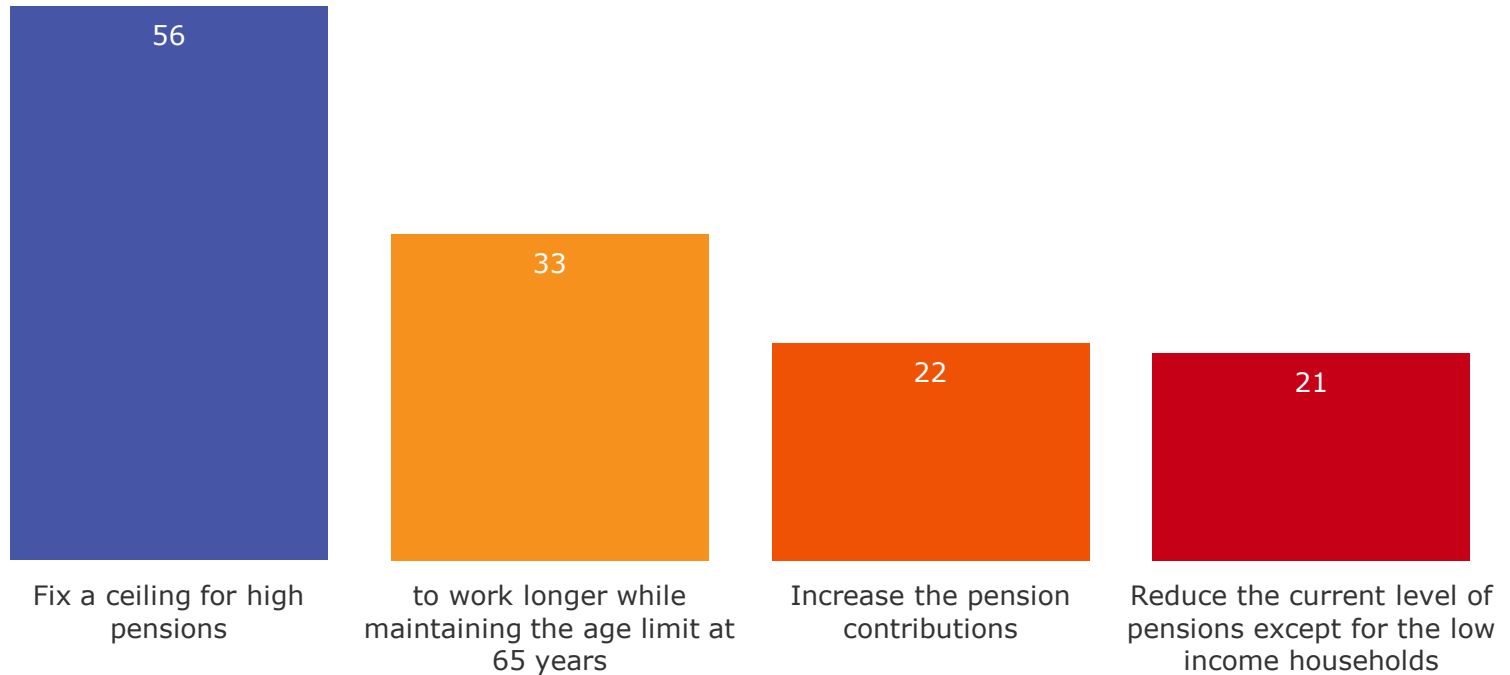

# Ways to balance the government budget

- ✓ The main approach cited by the residents and the commuters to balance the gouvernement budget is **to reduce government expenditure.**
- ✓ The second most popular approach is to adapt social spending according to the income level of the household – **social selectivity**
- ✓ The most appreciated measures are those proposing a reduction of public expenditure
- ✓ Contrary, an **increase in taxes** is according to the poll not the most popular measure to balance the government budget

# How to avoid to make the future generation pay for the pension debt

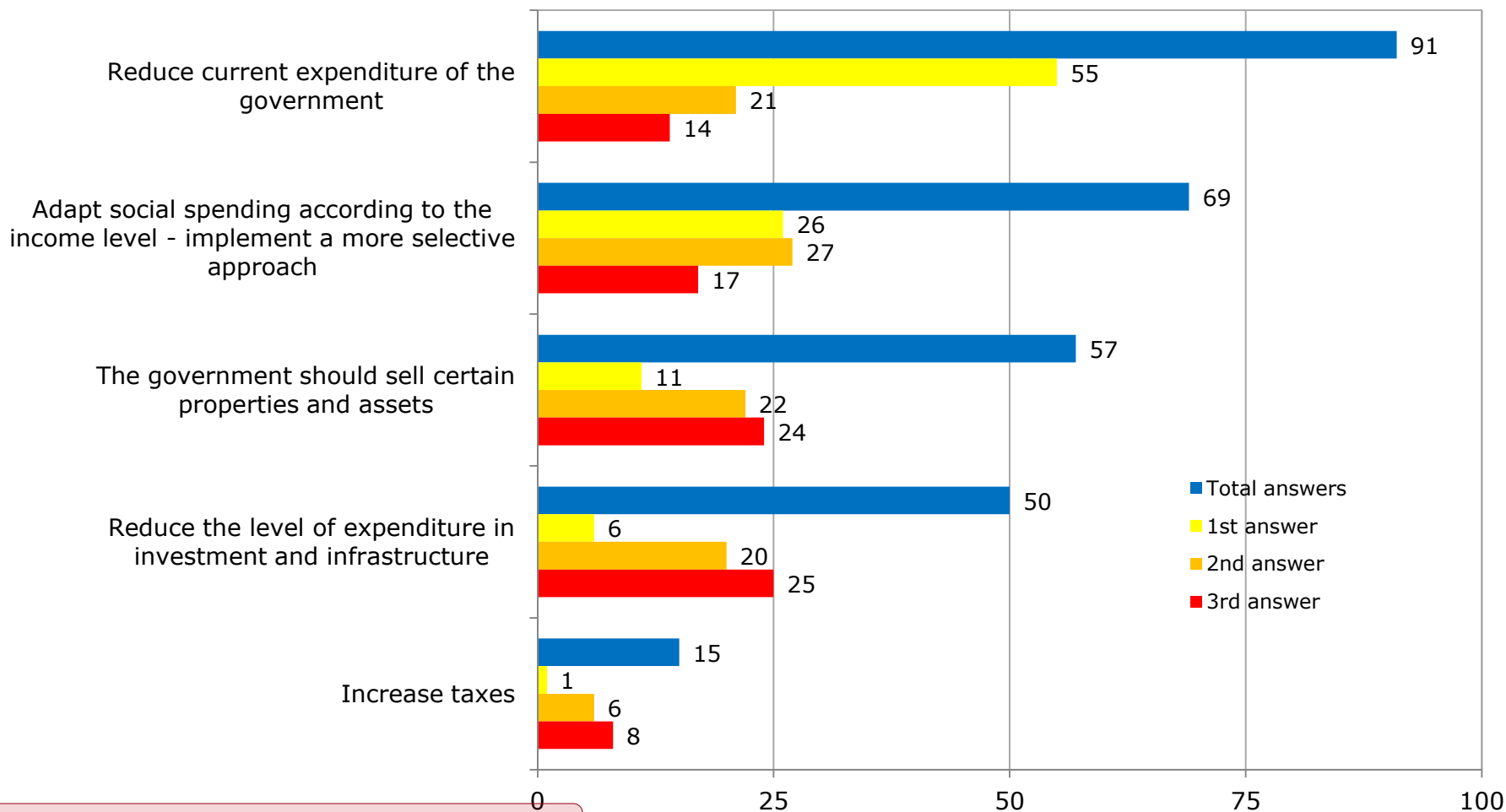
# *Que faire pour ne pas léguer la dette des pensions aux générations futures ?*

- ✓ Implementing a **ceiling for the pensions** is accepted by (only) 56% of the population
- ✓ 4 out of 5 citizens are against a **general reduction of the pensions**
- ✓ **There seems no clear measure which could solve the problem**
  - ✓ Only a third would be willing to work a bit longer
  - ✓ Only 1 out of 5 would accept an increase in the level of contributions
- ✓ What is the level of awareness of the citizens regarding the gravity of this issue and the readiness to find a solution among the citizens?

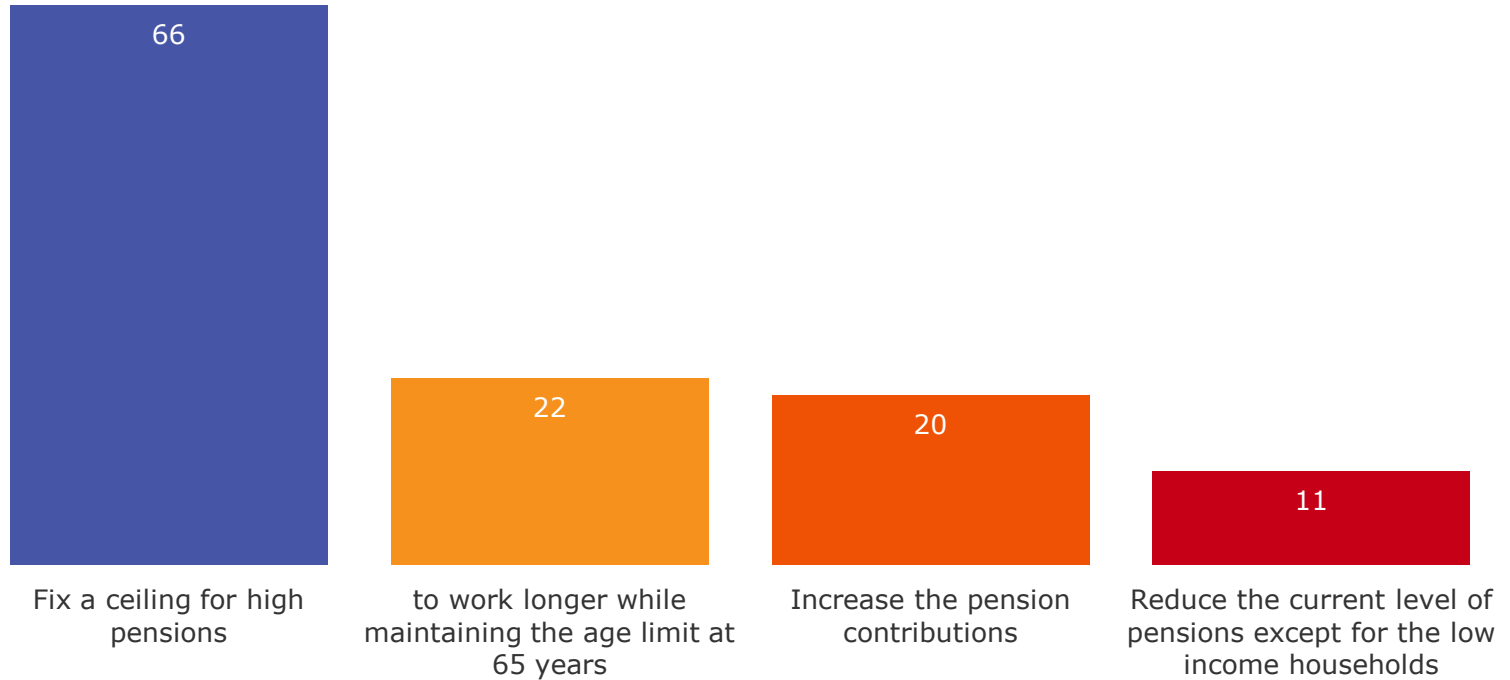
